## **Parish Fund Raising 2017**

**Dear Parishioners:** To the admiration of the Archbishop and the Diocese, Our Lady and St Patrick's has raised over the last 10 years in excess of £155,000. This is a remarkable sum and a commitment that is unique to us. We can be proud of our devotion to our Church and Parish.

Despite this tremendous achievement, 2016 vs. 2015 saw a fall in fund raising revenue by 33%. That is to say, in 2016 in order to achieve our commitment to the Diocese's loan of £20,000 per annum, we drew monies from the redundant 'Tesco Voucher Scheme' and from the 300+Club to the tune of £6000. The Tesco voucher scheme no longer exists, and no longer provides revenue to us.

Our parishioners continue to do the best they can to support fund raising activities against all the odds, but we must advise everyone that now in the third quarter of 2017, we are facing a considerable deficit in revenue to achieve our commitment to the diocese of £20,000 per annum. Consequently we are launching a series of fund raising events through October into early December that should appeal to all tastes and pockets with events to excite and entertain you. Please help us to support our Parish Church.
