5TH SUNDAY IN LENT MESSAGE FROM FATHER EDMUND

Dearly Beloved in Christ,

"I lift up my eyes to the mountains from where shall come my help? My help shall come from the Lord who made heaven and earth." *Psalm 121*.

I hope and pray you are all keeping safe and well in this difficult time...

I will like to express my sincere gratitude to all of you who have been calling and texting to check on me to make sure I am doing well. Thanks be to God, by His grace and mercy, I am blessed, highly favoured and protected in the Precious Blood of the Lamb, Our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. and pray you are all equally Blessed and favoured.

It is my greatest hope that even though the Church building is closed from public worship due to the coronavirus pandemic, our hearts are widely open to the Lord, the Most Holy Trinity and to all the Holy Angels and Saints, that the worship of the One True God may continue, wherever we are, in Spirit and in Truth. (*Cf. John 4:23-24*)

The Holy Sacrifice of the Mass is offered daily for your intentions and the 'Light of Hope' is lit in the Church on your behalf. Please remember that no matter the 'darkness' that may surround us, the little flame of the candle light can lead us through to the promises of God.

May we be encouraged not to focus our attention so much on the 'darkness' presented by the Coronavirus Pandemic which brings anxiety and distress, but rather fix our gaze on Christ Jesus, Our Saviour and redeemer who is the true Light of the World and says "anyone who follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life." (John 8;12) and has promised that he will be with us until the end of time. (Cf. Matthew 28:20)

Let us endeavour to create a sacred moment in our lives each day to read the Word of God, for "blessed is the one who delights in the Law of the Lord and meditates on the Law day and night" (*Cf. Psalm 1:2*); Pray the Holy Rosary and practice some of the rich devotions of the Church and call upon the Name of the Lord our God to come to our aid that this Pandemic may be overcome and His glory be revealed.

Trusting in the Lord I am sure that at the end, we will all come out stronger in faith, unity and Love as witnesses of God's goodness and salvation in the world.

Through the intercession of the Blessed Mary and all the Saints, may we be strengthened and Blessed with God's favour and protection, that we may see His goodness and mercies all the days of our life and come to share in His Eternal Glory at the end of time.
